LOW INCOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIEAP) ENROLLMENT PERIOD December 18, 2023 THROUGH MARCH 29, 2024

Assistance with energy bills is available in Kansas for low-income households that meet certain qualifications. The Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP) is a Federally-funded program that helps eligible households pay a portion of their home energy costs by providing a one-time per year benefit. Applications are made through the Kansas Department of Children and Families.

The 2024 application period is December 18, 2023 through Friday, March 29, 2024, prior to 5:00 p.m. Here are the basic eligibility provisions for qualifying for assistance:

- 1. An adult living at the address must be personally responsible for paying the heating costs incurred at the current residence, payable either to the landlord or the fuel vendor.
- 2. Applicants must demonstrate a recent history of payments toward purchase of the primary heating energy.
- 3. The household must qualify under the following income guidelines:

The combined gross income (before deductions) of all persons living at the address may not exceed 150% of the federal poverty level according to the guidelines listed below:
